In 2016, Indigenous Australians aged 15-64 were 1.9 times as likely to be not employed as non-Indigenous Australians. Differences in employment rates between Indigenous males and females narrowed between 2006 and 2016, with an increase for females (43.2% to 44.8%) and a decrease for males (53% to 48.5%) among those aged 15-64.
