Whether it’s about toddler tantrums or teen angst, Howerton reveals how she learned to opt out from the pressure to do it all perfectly and opt in to excelling at average. Poignant and relatable, *Rage Against the Minivan* is a permission slip to allow yourself to be a “good enough” parent, learning how to love your kids well while letting yourself off the hook.
