Example in this ebook D. Florencio Varela nació en Buenos Aires el día 23 de Febrero de 1807. Fué su padre D. Jacobo Adrian Varela, español del cuño antiguo, cuyo nombre se conserva en las tradiciones de la defensa de Buenos Aires, por la gallardía con que se mantuvo con su cuerpo, en la posición del Retiro, embestida por dos divisiones inglesas, y la inteligencia con que salvó su compañía al frente del enemigo vencedor. D. Jacobo Adrian tuvo la fortuna de ver coronado por el triunfo mas espléndido su consagración á la independencia de la patria de sus hijos; pero este fué el único desquite que le fué dado tomar contra un enemigo que acababa de consumir

su ruina, apoderándose en Montevideo de un buque en que habia invertido todo el capital que giraba en el comercio. Una herencia de honor y de pobreza fué, pues, el patrimonio que Florencio Varela recibió al nacer. Su corazon y su inteligencia empezaron á formarse en la escuela de la adversidad, que es la que mejor prepara al hombre para la vida activa en tiempos calamitosos. Su padre, atacado de una enfermedad mortal, ocupaba sus ocios en enseñarle á leer, escribir y contar. El tierno discípulo era tambien el enfermero del anciano, á quien asistió hasta la hora de su muerte, que tuvo lugar en el invierno de 1818. Varela tenia 11 años. El general Puigredon, Director del Estado, acababa de fundar el colegio de la Union del Sud. La madre de Florencio solicitó una beca de gracia para su hijo; y allí hizo sus estudios preparatorios. Cuatro años despues dejó el colegio é ingresó á la facultad de jurisprudencia en la Universidad, y en Agosto de 1827, á los 20 años de edad, se graduó de Doctor, recibiendo el título gratuito que se acuerda al candidato que mas se distingue en los exámenes de prueba. El jóven Varela habia descollado entre sus condiscípulos, no tanto por su contraccion á los estudios escolares, como por su talento claro, por su memoria prodijiosa, por su instruccion literaria adquirida privadamente en la lectura asídua de poetas españoles y franceses. Este amor á las bellas letras, á que lo arrastraban el ejemplo de su hermano D. Juan Cruz y la natural inclinacion de su espíritu, llegó á distraerlo á tal punto de sus estudios profesionales, que hubo de verse espuesto á no poder rendir exámen de uno de los cursos de derecho. Amonestado por su maestro, Varela volvió sobre sí; aprovechó el único mes que

faltaba para la conclusion del año escolar, se presentó á exámen, y obtuvo la primera clasificacion por voto unánime de sus jueces. A principios de 1825 fué nombrado para un empleo subalterno en una secretaría de Estado. Entre el desempeño de sus deberes oficiales, y sus estudios profesionales, Varela hacia sus primeros ensayos en la carrera literaria y en la vida pública. Escribia versos que publicaba en los periódicos que redactaba su hermano mayor, y seguia las opiniones que este sostenia, como el órgano mas autorizado y mas capaz del partido unitario. Poco despues de subir al mando el coronel Dorrego, hizo renuncia de su empleo, no creyendo delicado conservarse al lado de una administracion de quien era ardiente opositor. Despues de la revolucion de 1°. de Diciembre de 1828, fué nombrado oficial mayor de Relaciones Exteriores. En ella habia tomado la poca parte que su edad le permitia; sin embargo su adhesion al partido unitario en que tanto figuraba el nombre de sus hermanos, le obligó á seguir la suerte de estos, cuando emigraron á Montevideo en Agosto de 1829, poco despues de la abdicacion del jeneral Lavalle. En Octubre del mismo año regresaron á Buenos Aires; pero les salió al encuentro una órden de destierro, y sin que se les permitiese desembarcar volvieron á una espatriacion que para casi todos los hermanos debia ser eterna.
