Robin Adèle Greeley examines such central works as Miró's Still Life with Old Shoe and Dalí's Autumn Cannibalism in the context of contemporary works and historical events. A Life of Picasso

The exhibition "Picasso, 1905-1906" has allowed an extension, albeit only a temporary one, of the permanent collections of the Picasso Museum in Barcelona. It consisted in fact of a compilation of the work which came immediately after Picasso's departure from Catalonia, in April 1904, at the end of his Blue Period. Through this exhibition, it has been possible to see the extent to which the artist's roots were fixed in the Catalan art of the end of the century. At the same time, the artistic effervescence of Paris and his contacts with what was to become the vanguard of European culture stimulated him and encouraged his ceaseless, determined search for a new and original form of painting which was to lead to a decisive change in his artistic language.

This is a highly informative and interesting work covering a period of military history that has been largely neglected.
